

## Director Compensation

Those who serve Technology Learning Center as board members or advisors do not receive compensation for their services. They are volunteers.

They may be reimbursed for approved travel related expenses incurred while conducting official TLC business. This includes transportation, meals, lodging and gratuities. Board meetings, school visits, public relations events or fund raising activities are examples of official TLC business. Board members may also receive compensation for expenses related to participating in online meetings including equipment and IT services.

Board members are strongly urged to avoid any appearance of political lobbying on behalf of TLC. There is absolutely no reimbursement for any expense remotely connected to a political event. Teacher union conventions and gatherings are considered political events.

Advancing the cause of TLC at the school board level is not considered political lobbying and is encouraged for everyone connected with TLC. This includes staff, volunteers and members of the board.

The board in its discretion reserves the right to limit reimbursements for junkets and other activities that may be considered extravagant or frivolous for organizations of similar size.
