

Lab Participation

Every student must have the written permission of a parent or legal guardian to participate in the Professor Know-How Lab. Parents are also made to understand that participation in the program is voluntary and not part of a school's required curriculum. Parents are required to detail any medical condition or emotional issue that might create a hazard for their student or others in a class. This includes the reporting of any past problems or issues.

Parental Responsibilities

Any student who doesn't obey the rules of safety or otherwise is disruptive will be removed from the class and not allowed further participation. Parents also agree to discuss with their children the program's safety policy. Parents are required to make certain their children have a clear understanding that experiments conducted in their lessons at school are not to be attempted at home. Parents also must agree to discuss program policies about any individual contact with adult classroom volunteers outside approved programs. Parents are charged with exercising due diligence in monitoring their children and reporting any suspected violation of the policy.

In the case where a child has alleged abuse or where abuse is suspected, the parent's first action must be to immediately contact the appropriate law enforcement agency. This is the policy that unequivocally applies to every person in our organization.
