

Online Privacy & Security

The Technology Learning Center respects the privacy of our online visitors and we are committed to providing a safe and secure experience for the users of our site.

Among the most important policies we want our visitors and contributors to know is: we will not sell, trade, or give out e-mail addresses to companies or other organizations. We will not intentionally disclose any personal identifiable information about you as an individual user (such as, for example, your full name, street address, telephone number or e-mail address) to any third party without having first received your permission.

It is important to note that if you publish personal information on a message board or participate in online social media, any references to, or comments you make concerning TLC, is now in the public domain. That information may be collected and used by third parties. Although we strive to protect a visitor's privacy, we cannot guarantee the security of information you post in these arenas. This is a decision you make entirely at your own risk.

There are exceptions to this policy that require TLC to release certain personal information in order to comply with a request by the Internal Revenue Service or any valid legal process such as a search warrant, subpoena, statute or court order. These exceptions are extremely rare.

Privacy of Minors

The Technology Learning Center does not solicit personal information from minors. Consistent with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act of 1998, we will never knowingly request personally identifiable information from anyone under the age of thirteen (13) without prior verifiable parental consent.

Security of Credit Card Information

The Technology Learning Center has chosen EFT Corporation to process donations on this website. This system uses an advanced data encryption system to ensure the security and confidentiality of information exchanged between your browser and EFT's e-commerce server.

When making a donation to TLC, you have the option to save basic personal information for ease of future contributions. Credit card information including account numbers, expiration dates and security codes are never stored or recorded.
