



Kids Beg to Attend Professor Know-How's Lab at Kennesaw Charter Science & Math Academy



One of the most popular teachers at Kennesaw Charter Science & Math Academy is Jim Phillips, aka "Professor Know-How," the founder and creator of the school's hands on Technology Learning Center, an after school elective activity at KCSMA.

As Professor Know-How, Phillips has created a hip clubhouse and learning lab where KCSMA students literally beg to go. In the lab small groups of students take things apart, build things and unlock the secrets of the gadgets and machines they use every day. The program, Phillips says, is inspired by the ancient proverb, "Tell me and I'll forget; show me and I may remember; involve me and I will understand."

Typical student comments: "Professor Know-How's Lab was the best week I have ever had in school." "I kept on telling my mom I couldn't wait for tomorrow to come. Even though I was tired, I could hardly sleep the night before because I wanted to come to the lab really bad." "This class makes me want to come to school even MORE!
